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Only a few of these symptoms may be present.

ACT FAST! Symptoms can be life-threatening!

weak pulse, dizziness, passing out HEART

- STOMACH vomiting, diarrhea, cramps LUNG shortness of breath, cough, wheeze,

- itching, hives, redness, swelling
