Fellow Exam Information

or those interested in attaining AAOA Fellow status, the 2023 Fellow Exam will be held in two parts: an online written exam and an online oral exam.

Candidates must meet the criteria to complete the exam process to attain AAOA Fellow status. The following lists the current requirements needed in addition to the written Fellow Exam and the oral Fellow Exam.

- Certification by the American Board of Otolaryngology Head and Neck Surgery or the American Osteopathic Board of Ophthalmology and Otolaryngology Head and Neck Surgery (AOBOOHNS)
- Member of the AAOA for a minimum of one (1) year
- Attendance at 1 complete AAOA Basic Course in Allergy & Immunology within the past five (5) years
- Attendance at 1 complete AAOA Advanced Course in Allergy & Immunology within the past five (5) years
- Attendance at 1 complete AAOA Annual Meeting within the past five (5) years
- Attendance at 1 additional AAOA-sponsored CME program within the past five (5) years
- Attestation of primary treatment of ten (10) immunotherapy patients who have been on immunotherapy for at least 6 months
- Completed AAOA Fellow Exam application & fee by April 1st
- Payment of \$950 (Late applications will be assessed \$1,350 if received between April 1 and April 15)

The deadline to submit the above-noted documentation is April 1.

Incomplete applications and those received after April 15 will not be considered.

The AAOA voting membership is comprised of American Board of Otolaryngology Head and Neck Surgery (ABOto) certified or eligible physicians who have already demonstrated their competence and qualifications as otolaryngologists through their residency training and certification by the ABOto. Fellows of the AAOA have supplemented their otolaryngology training and expertise by passing the AAOA Fellow Exam. Fellows of the AAOA are Board Certified by the American Board of Otolaryngology Head and Neck Surgery. As such, a Fellow of the AAOA may define herself or himself as a Fellow of the AAOA with the ABMS-Board Certification in Otolaryngology, the scope of which includes the diagnosis and management of allergy of the upper aerodigestive tract.

Fellows of the AAOA

The status of AAOA Fellow will be granted to candidates who meet all the eligibility criteria and who pass both the oral and written parts of the Fellow Exam.

Maintaining AAOA Fellow status requires active membership and is contingent upon the attendance at 2 AAOA-sponsored courses or meetings during each subsequent 5-year cycle from the date Fellow status is granted.

In light of recent alterations in the AAOA course schedule due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the list of qualifying courses for fulfilling the 2023 Fellow Exam educational requirements has been expanded.
